In 2021, we launched Well Women, a social enterprise to empower at-risk women who enroll in our sewing program through employment. The women learn to sew, creating fair-trade products that we sell through online marketing and boutique partnerships.

Education

- 1. Increase the student population by 10 percent
- 2. Add a teacher to decrease classroom size
- 3.Ensure graduation of at least five women from the Vocational Sewing Program



- 1. Add one community outreach session per month
- 2. Train students to share the Gospel with unreached populace
- 3. Continue Guest Pastor Program with six sessions in 2022

Humanitarian Aid

- 1. Employ families to assist with Well Women social enterprise
- 2. Provide grants for families to enable them to stay in school when faced with financial difficulties



- 1. Provide transportation to and from class for students and staff who live more than 30 minutes from school
- 2.Partner with United Bible Training Center to provide semiannual ministry training programs for women & girls
- 3. Maintain female enrollment at 50 percent of student population
